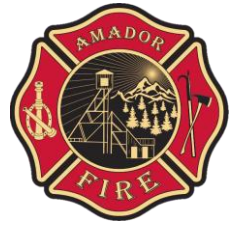

Establishing an Eligibility List FIRE PREVENTION OFFICER

The Position:

Under the general supervision of the Fire Chief, working independently, performs responsible, technical and specialized work of a difficult and complex nature in the fields of fire and life safety inspections; reviews and approves routine to moderately complex building construction plans and emergency plans for compliance with state and local fire and life safety standards and regulations; responsible for enforcement of applicable life and safety code and ordinances; provides technical consultations and assistance to industries and other governmental agencies; performs engineering assignments; conducts field inspections to ensure compliance with state and local standards; may act for and in the absence of the Fire Chief; acts as the primary fire investigator within the District's boundaries, performs other duties as required.

Work Schedule:

40 hours a week with schedule flexibility and additional on call for fire investigations

Minimum Qualifications: (Resume and Copies of all Minimum Qualification certificates and licenses must be attached with your application)

- Candidate must be at least 18 years of age;
- Possession of a Valid California Class C license or higher (Must attach a DMV printout showing class of license);
The following may be obtained with first year of employment:
- Associate's degree from an accredited College or equivalent in education and experience
- CFSTES Fire Prevention Officer I;
- CFSTES Fire Investigator;
- P.O.S.T. 832 PC certificate (A); and
- Basic knowledge of firefighting techniques and practices

Desired Qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in a related field
- (CFSTES) Fire Prevention Officer II Certificate
- CCAI CFI/IAAI CFI
- IEC Fire Inspector I
- Two years' full-time experience as a fire prevention officer/ building inspector and two years of experience as a fire investigator;
- Basic knowledge of Amador County Code (Municipal Codes; specifically, 15.30)

Salary and Benefits (not all benefits may be listed):

- \$75,000 annually (and is negotiable depending on qualifications)
- Paid holidays, vacation and sick leave
- Medical, dental, and vision care plans or \$400 cash-in-lieu for medical
- \$700 annual uniform allowance, \$400 annual training allowance and Career training benefit

The examination for this recruitment may consist of the following: application and resume appraisal, scenario-based evaluation and a Chief's interview. Applications will be reviewed for minimum and desired qualifications and up to ten candidates will be scheduled for further testing. An offer of employment is conditional pending the results of an employment entrance medical examination including drug screening and an extensive criminal background check. Applicants must provide verification of legal right to work in the United States at the time of job offer.

Applications with resumes will be accepted by mail or in person at the Amador Fire Protection District Administrative Office, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. **Applications must be received by the closing date; postmark date will not be accepted.
